<p>MATERIAL AND RESOURCES</p> <p>MR Credit 4.1, 4.2 – RECYCLED CONTENT (>20% post-consumer)</p>	<p>Intent: Increase the demand for building products that incorporate recycled content materials, thereby reducing impacts resulting from extraction and processing of virgin materials.</p> <p>Requirement: Use materials with recycled content such that the sum of the post-consumer recycled content plus one-half of the pre-consumer (post-industrial) content constitutes at least 10% or 20% of the total value of the materials in the product.</p> <p>SUPERCAP & SUPERCAP FAST contains more than 20% post-industrial recycled content. Supercap uses more than 1 million pounds of recycled material annually. The primary source of our post-industrial recycled material comes from the power plants that burn coal and account for more than half of the electricity produced in the United States. These materials were previously disposed of in landfills.</p>
<p>MR Credit 5.1, 5.2 – REGIONAL MATERIALS</p> <p>LEED-NC – 20% Extracted, Processed & Manufactured Regionally</p> <p>LEED-CI – 20% Manufactured Regionally</p>	<p>Intent: Increase demand for building materials and products that are extracted and manufactured within the region, thereby supporting the use of indigenous resources and reducing the environmental impacts resulting from transportation.</p> <p>Requirement: LEED-NC – Use building products that have been extracted, harvested or recovered, as well as manufactured, within 500 miles of the project site for a minimum of 10% or 20% (based on cost) of the total materials value. If only a fraction of the product is extracted, harvested or recovered and manufactured locally, then only that percentage (by weight) shall contribute to the regional value.</p> <p>LEED-CI – Use a minimum of 20% of all construction and Division 12 (furniture) materials and products that are manufactured regionally within a radius of 500 miles.</p> <p>Refer to our website www.supercap.us.com for the most current listing of Supercap Installers and locations necessary to calculate the actual contribution for this credit, depending on the Mobile Blending Unit locations as provided by Pump Trucks Industrial LLC.</p>
